| 4. Avanti Chenin / Torrontes (Argentina) | £12.95 |
| Fresh and ripe, with flavours of peach and lemon, and citrus flower notes on the nose. Just off-dry. | |
| 5. Villa Rosa Sauvignon (Chile) | £13.50 |
| The nose is full of clean and youthful green Sauvignon fruit. Clean and soft on the palate, where pear flavours emerge. Great length - a very appealing style. | |
| 6. Castle Creek Chardonnay (Australia) | £13.95 |
| A medium-full wine with lovely peach, melon and vanilla flavours. The palate shows abundant peach and melon fruit, with a clean, dry finish of good length. | |
| 7. Rocheburg Chenin Blanc (South Africa) | £13.50 |
| A refreshing, zesty, unoaked Chenin Blanc, packed full of fresh tropical fruit flavours of pineapple, peach and apple. Very versatile. | |
| 8. San Antonio Pinot Grigio (Italy) | £14.50 |
| Light straw colour with green tints, a fruity, flowery bouquet and a medium body. | |
| 9. Brown Brothers Everton White (Australia) | £15.50 |
| Sassy unwooded, dry white. Delicate aromas of peach, apricot and almonds. On the palate - fresh, crisp and lively with attractive fruit flavours. | |

10. Cougars Moon White Zinfandel (USA) £13.45
Lots of jammy, red berry fruit. An increasingly recognisable and popular grape variety.
11. San Antonio Pinot Grigio Rosato (USA) £14.45
Lots of jammy, red berry fruit. An increasingly recognisable and popular grape variety.

Red Wine Selection

12. Azabache Tempranillo (Spain) £13.50
Pure unadulterated fruit that is fresh, juicy and with great overtones of cloves and spices. The wine displays soft, round jammy red fruit - lip-smacking
14. Avanti Malbec (Argentina) £13.75
Dark, smooth and richly fruity with generous ripe mulberry and plum flavours.
15. Villa Rosa Merlot (Chile) £13.95
Deep violet-red colour and an attractive smoky, plummy nose. Medium bodied and well-balanced, soft, fruity and deliciously easy-drinking.
16. Richmond Ridge Shiraz / Cabernet (Australia) £14.50
Clear, bright crimson with a pink rim. Fresh, lively spice with pronounced berried fruit on the nose. A medium bodied wine with cherry/plum and soft fruit aftertaste.
17. Baron Phillippe Rothschild Pinot Noir (France) £14.95
Vin de Pay's d'Oc. A fresh, medium red wine packed with red berry fruit and spice. Supple tannins and an easy-drinking style makes this wine a perfect all-rounder for most occasions.
18. Hawkes Peak Red (USA - California) £13.95
Fontella is a modern range of central Italian classics from Tuscany, Lazio and Umbria. The Chianti is a fresh, redcurrant and blackberry wine from Sangiovese
19. Brown Brothers Everton Red (Australia) £15.95
Ripe red berry fruit, violets, subtle oak and a slightly gamey character.

20. Veuve Valmante Brut NV (France) £13.95
Crisp, refreshing fizz. Flavours of apple and citrus fruit, with toasty / yeasty overtones.
21. Veuve Valmante Rose NV (France) £13.95
Crisp, pink fizz. Flavours of strawberry fruit, with toasty / yeasty overtones.
